Our faith should be defined by something more than the fruitless effort to overturn *Roe v. Wade*. The abortion issue is cleverly raised by Republicans while they pass the fund-raising hat, but gets passed over when it comes time for them to do anything about it. It's time to look at the bigger picture.

THE COMMON GOOD. THE BETTER CHOICE.

There is no question Senator Obama will address the issues that reflect Catholic social teaching.

Senator Obama supports paid maternity leave to make sure families won't lose their employment and much-needed income after having a child. In the Obama

health plan, no one would be denied health care coverage because of a pre-existing condition. Senator McCain's plan to tax employee health care benefits will force as many as 20 million people into the ranks of the uninsured.

Senator Obama will make sure full-time workers can support families by raising the minimum wage to \$9.50 an hour by 2011. McCain, on the other hand, voted against minimum wage increases and voted to completely repeal the minimum wage in 45 states. Nineteen times.

Senator Obama voted to extend Medicaid coverage to pregnant women and infants below the federal poverty line. He voted for the State Children's Health Insurance Program, which offers care to more than 6 million children. McCain voted against it. Twice.

VOTE OBAMA. BECAUSE THERE IS LIFE IN EVERY ISSUE.

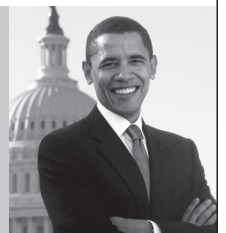
